Itinerary: BUE – Mercedes – Irupé Lodge – Mercedes – BUE (3 Nights)
Dates: September 15 to 18, 2018

Day 1 (September 15)

21.05 departure by night bus sleeping seat from Retiro. Dinner Snack on board.

Day 2 (September 16)

6 am arrival to Mercedes and transfer into the wetlands. 8 am approx. arrival at Irupé lodge. Breakfast. Soft trekking to the monkey jungle and along the pampas trail and main wooden bridge, short introductory visit to the park museum. Lunch. Relax. First boat safari into different wetland areas to observe wildlife and the Ibera's birds face to face, eventually sunset on the lake. Dinner and night Irupé Lodge.

Day 3 (September 17)

Safari combination leaving Irupé Lodge by boat, investigating the channels south of the wetlands where the largest caimans live and nest. After getting off the boat at a remote wooden bridge you will explore a private nature reserve on horseback. The ride takes you along the lake, Caranday palm tree forests, reeds and natural jungles. Picnic at the manor of a cattle and buffalo estancia. Drive back to the lodge by 4WD. Time for relax. Dinner. Night expedition into the mystic marsh accompanied by the stars and the gleaming eyes of the caimans. Night Irupé Lodge.

Day 4 (September 18)

10 am transfer Colonia Carlos Pellegrini – Mercedes. 1 pm public bus Mercedes/Buenos Aires with arrival to Retiro around 11 pm. End of our services.

Day 1 (September 22)

7.30 am departure by day bus from Retiro. 5 pm arrival to Mercedes and transfer into the wetlands. 7 pm approx. arrival at Irupé lodge. Check-in, relax, dinner. Night expedition into the mystic marsh accompanied by the stars and the gleaming eyes of the caimans. Night Irupé Lodge.

Day 2 (September 23)

Soft trekking to the monkey jungle and along the pampas trail and main wooden bridge, short introductory visit to the park museum. Lunch. Relax. First boat safari into different wetland areas to observe wildlife and the Ibera's birds face to face, eventually sunset on the lake. Dinner and night Irupé Lodge.

Day 3 (September 24)

Safari combination leaving Irupé Lodge by boat, investigating the channels south of the wetlands where the largest caimans live and nest. After getting off the boat at a remote wooden bridge you will explore a private nature reserve on horseback. The ride takes you along the lake, Caranday palm tree forests, reeds and natural jungles.
