DAY 2 Otavalo Full Day

- After a hearty breakfast you will meet the safe keepers of Ecuadorian traditions that have dedicated their lives to keeping their ancestral culture alive.
- Pleated or flat skirt? Embroidered blouse? Tall crown and short brimmed hat? The traditional dress of indigenous tribes does not follow fashion trends; it is one of the holdouts of humans' cultural adaptations over the years. It is a source and product of the indigenous peoples' handicraft, artistry and differentiation. Vibrant, handwoven textiles, stacks and stacks of hats, alpargata shoes, golden necklaces and warm ponchos are all part and parcel of daily work and life. Every garment has different characteristics allowing the knowledgeable to identify which of the 14 coexisting tribes in Ecuador each person belongs to. Additionally music, gastronomy and decorative craftwork are all fortitudes of Ecuador's indigenous peoples. Spend an unforgettable moment in the company of these great hosts and get acquainted with their cosmovision.



Following this ancestral awakening, a delicious dinner waits for in Sarance Restaurant, back at your home, Hotel Otavalo. Sarance means "People who live up right" and is the ancient name of Otavalo.

DAY 3 Otavalo – Quito

- An early morning will be perfect to discover one of the natural wonders of the Andeans Mountains. We will find out what happens to certain volcanoes over centuries... You will see one of them filled with stories and great surprises.
- After this morning's visit we will continue south following the Andean corridor to the capital, Quito. We believe that every road trip is an opportunity to explore the communities we're surrounded by for some surprises, be captivated by them...

Lunch at Molino San Juan, its history will charm you while seeing amazing Roses in an old barn.

Arrival to Quito's Historical Downtown (UNESCO World Heritage Site)

- Leap back in time into Colonial Latin America, traipse along columned corridors into skylit central patios and out onto romantic balconies. Devout or not, hail the marvelous architecture and beauty of the churches, cathedrals and convents exhibiting various periods of art within the historic centers of Quito and Cuenca. Watch the curtain rise in theatres graced by famous orchestras, plays and dramatized folklore. Theatrized expositions and walking tours bring to life past protagonists biographical, legendary or mythical. Take part in the living history of the best preserved colonial centers whose residents fiercely protect and promote their customs. Where the local barista not only brews the perfect high altitude arabica coffee, but also concocts works of art in fabric, wood and wax. Feast on home cooked meals in restaurants where secret family recipes have not been diverged nor divulged from generation to generation. Ultimately, call one of these colonial houses, with incredible personalized service, home for the night.
- Recharged? Now we will visit some "vecinos". The neighbors that still keep the traditions and culture of Quiteños alive! Also enjoy access to very exclusive places in 15 and 16th century buildings... Remember the Hero's Journey... we have said too much already...
