Embark on a journey through Ecuador's cultural and natural heritage. Begin with a drive to Molino de San Juan, near the Cayambe volcano. Explore the landscape of the Cayambe-Coca Ecological Reserve and learn about the history of indigenous communities in the region.

DAY BY DAY ITINERARY

DAY 1 . ANGLA COMMUNITY - OTAVALO INDIGENOUS MARKET – TRANSFER TO MOLINO DE SAN JUAN (L,D)

Today, we will drive north towards Imbabura, also known as the Lake Province, while enjoying an exciting trip by tasting exotic fruit in the Guayllabamba valley. Cross the Equatorial Line in Cayambe, where on a clear day, it is possible to admire its majestic snow-capped volcano (5,790 m. / 18,996 ft), the world's highest point crossed by the equator. This is an ideal spot to try Cayambe's famous salt biscuits with leaf cheese, this region's traditional snack. At the base of Imbabura volcano, you will be able to enjoy the picturesque view of Ecuador's largest lake - San Pablo.

Afterwards, we will visit the local Angla indigenous community. During this visit you will have authentic insights into the community's everyday life, actively learning about their traditions and experiencing unforgettable cultural encounters. Here, you will enjoy a natural healing ritual called Andean "Chakana" which merges traditional indigenous and religious beliefs. You will also create cherished memories with the community by making



traditional beverages and feel the peace of being surrounded by the awe-inspiring Imbabura Volcano and the stunning San Pablo Lake. This visit will undoubtedly immerse you in Ecuador's indigenous culture.



When we arrive in the town of Otavalo, it will be time to visit its world-famous Indigenous Market, the largest in South America. Here is where vendors proudly offer a stunning variety of weavings such as the famous ponchos, among other textiles like rugs, mittens, and scarves. This market is like a rainbow due to the colors of the textiles exhibited. Without a doubt, it is an ideal place to find handicrafts, jewelry, and other artisanal craftwork. Accommodation at Hacienda Molino de San Juan

Molino San Juan is the living testimony of the culture of grinding wheat to produce flour.

The walls of adobe of the Mill keep the customs of the wheat farm "The Compañía de Jesús", that was one of the great colonial patrimonies of the religious congregation Society of Jesus (Jesuits); hence his name. The history of the hacienda "The Company" dates back to the sixteenth century and since 1812 it is owned by the Jarrin family and their descendants



DAY 2 . CAYAMBE VOLCANO - PM: AT LEISURE (B, D)

Today, we will drive north, Cross the Equatorial Line, from here, we'll be able to admire today's destination, the imposing snow-capped Cayambe volcano, standing at 5,790 m or 18,996 ft, it is the highest point on Earth crossed by the equator. We will make our way to the Cayambe-Coca Ecological Reserve, an area that extends through four provinces (Imbabura, Pichincha, Napo and Sucumbios), and holds many important ecosystems from the paramo grasslands in the Highlands to the cloud forests and rainforests of the Amazon.



We will take a 45-minute ride down a dirt road until we arrive at the foot of the Cayambe Volcano. After another 30 minutes, we will arrive at the Ruáles Oleas Berge Refuge, located at an altitude of 4,700 m or 15,419 ft. At the refuge, you will have a beautiful view of the magnificent landscapes that surround the volcano and, if we're lucky, even see the iconic Andean Condor in flight above us. We can also visit the "Hermoso" Glacier, ideal for people who want to have a closer look at the volcano and have some fun in the snow.

In the afternoon, you'll have free time to explore the Hacienda Molino de San Juan at your leisure.



OPTIONAL HOT AIR BALLOON THEDERED FLIGHT OVER HACIENDA MOLINO DE SAN JUAN IN THE MORNING:

Experience a hot air balloon ride over Hacienda Molino de San Juan. Marvel at panoramic views of Cayambe Volcano and the surrounding valleys as you float through the air. Capture memorable moments and

immerse yourself in Ecuador's natural beauty from a new perspective.

OPTIONAL ARTISAN BEER EXPERIENCE IN THE AFTERNOON:

This experience allows you to immerse yourself in the rich history and flavors of craft beer in Ecuador. Explore an underground cellar, where the Molino San Juan turbine, built in 1890, once operated, providing optimal conditions for storing and tasting craft beer. It's a unique and authentic attraction at Hacienda Molino San Juan.



OPTIONAL HORSEBACK RIDING IN THE AFTERNOON:

We will then head to Molino de San Juan for a horseback riding experience along exclusive trails throughout the hacienda's grounds. As we advance through the property, you'll have the opportunity to observe native bird species and enjoy spectacular landscapes. Later, return to the hacienda.

This experience is limited to a maximum of 2 persons

DAY 3: TRANSFER TO QUITO (B)

At an appropriate time, you will be picked up at your hotel and transferred to Quito
