### DAY 01 SAT, SEP 21st ARRIVAL TO GALAPAGOS

Begin your unforgettable journey with a flight from Quito to Galapagos. Upon landing at Baltra, your personal guide will be ready to greet you.

Your adventure starts with a scenic transfer to Puerto Ayora. This journey includes a short ferry ride across the picturesque Itabaca Channel, followed by a 45-minute drive through stunning landscapes with a stop in Santa Cruz Highlands.

Discover the diverse ecosystems of Santa Cruz Island, from the arid coastal areas to the lush, refreshing highlands. The highlands, which supply much of the drinking water for the island, are home to unique trees, ferns, colorful land birds, and the iconic giant tortoises.

Arrive at the beautiful Ikala Hotel, where you'll stay for four nights in a spacious room or suite (double occupancy). Enjoy daily breakfast and local taxes included in your stay, ensuring a comfortable and hassle-free experience.

### DAY 02 SUN, SEP 22nd PLAZAS (shared)

After breakfast, start your journey to the breathtaking South Plazas Island, known for its stunning landscapes. You'll experience a dry landing greeted by playful sea lions along the shore. Our adventure begins with a walk through an Opuntia Cactus forest. As you take in the beautiful scenery, be mindful of the ground, as this area is home to many land iguanas, the smallest species in the archipelago.

Continue your tour to the spectacular, windy cliffs where you'll see red-billed tropical birds, swallow-tailed gulls, brown pelicans, and the impressive frigate bird soaring overhead. The trail winds along the ridge for several hundred meters, offering incredible views and encounters with the "single sea lion colony," a diverse group of mostly elderly male sea lions with fascinating battle scars and shark bites.

After a delicious lunch onboard, dive into the crystal-clear waters at Carrion Point to explore the vibrant Galapagos marine life. Keep an eye out for white-tip sharks, a variety of fish, sea turtles, and rays.

Return to the Itabaca Channel where a bus will be ready to take you back to Puerto Ayora's pier, concluding an unforgettable day of adventure.

### DAY 03 MON, SEP 23rd FULL DAY TORTUGA BAY

Tortuga Bay, located southwest of Puerto Ayora on Santa Cruz Island, is a must-visit destination in the Galapagos. Named for its popularity among sea turtles that lay their eggs here, this stunning white sand beach is widely regarded as the most beautiful in the archipelago.

Accessing Tortuga Bay is an adventure in itself. Follow the well-marked and cobbled two-kilometer path starting at the west end of Charles Binford Street.

Along the path, enjoy excellent birdwatching opportunities, with sights of Darwin's finches and various sea birds. Tortuga Bay is also perfect for active visitors, offering great spots for kayaking, snorkeling, and surfing.

### DAY 04 TUE, SEP 24th NORTH SEYMOUR (shared)

Discover North Seymour Island, famed for its vibrant wildlife, including large colonies of blue-footed boobies and frigate birds. After a dry landing, embark on a 2.5 km hike to explore nesting sites and spot land and marine iguanas, sea lions, and pelicans.

This island is located north of Santa Cruz Island. It is known for its large colonies of blue-footed boobies and frigate birds, known as the Galapagos pirates.

Get ready to spot land iguanas and marine iguanas; also, a colony of sea lions, lava lizards, and pelicans!

Next, enjoy a delicious lunch on board before heading to Bachas Beach on Santa Cruz Island. Relax, swim, or snorkel in the crystal-clear waters teeming with colorful reef fish and rays. Bachas's beach is lovely, ideal for swimming, with a lagoon behind and a longer coast for walking and wildlife watching. The saltwater lagoon behind the beach often has great blue herons and small birds. Both the large and small beaches are nesting areas for green sea turtles.

As for snorkeling, during the activity, we may see many types of colorful reef fish and various rays, among other marine species.

End the day with a transfer back to Puerto Ayora, concluding an unforgettable adventure.
