Immerse yourself in the breathtaking history and landscapes of the Sacred Valley on this exclusive full-day private tour.



Used since pre-Inca times, these pools naturally produce salt as the sun evaporates mineral-rich spring water, creating a mesmerizing patchwork of colors and textures. Continue to the mystical Moray Terraces, a marvel of Inca agricultural engineering. These vast circular terraces, resembling giant amphitheaters, were likely an advanced agricultural laboratory where the Incas experimented with crop adaptation across microclimates. Marvel at this testament to Inca scientific and agricultural expertise, which allowed them to cultivate a wide variety of plants at different altitudes.
