Detailed Itinerary:

Wildlife Encounter on the Amazon River – 3 Days / 2 Nights

An immersive experience for those who want to dive into the amazon rainforest in a short time, without losing the authenticity or depth of a true connection with the Amazon. In just three days, you'll navigate the majestic Amazon River, venture into the rainforest in search of wildlife, connect with local guides who know the amazon as their home, and discover landscapes that will stay with you forever.

Day 1: First Encounter with the Rainforest (L/D)

From the moment you leave the city behind, the journey itself becomes part of the adventure. We'll pick you up from your hotel or the airport***. A three-hour trip by road and river takes you to Muyuna, where you'll witness the transition from Iquitos—the world's largest city with no road access—to the lush, green rainforest.

*****Recommended Flight Lima - Iquitos: Before 9 am**

1:00 pm – Arrival and Lunch

We welcome you with a fresh and local meal, while our guides introduce you to the lodge and our team.

3:00 pm – Encounter with the World's Smallest Monkey

On your first jungle walk, you'll head behind the lodge to explore the habitat of the pygmy marmoset, a tiny primate that defies its size with agility and charm.

7:00 pm – Dinner and Night Boat Exploration

When night falls, the jungle comes alive in a different way. We head out on a boat ride under the starry sky in search of caimans, night birds, and mammals that only appear when darkness settles over the river.

Day 2: The Magic of the Amazon (B/L/D)

6:30 am – Breakfast and Water Expedition

We start the day with an unforgettable experience: swimming in the Amazon alongside pink and gray dolphins, in a moment of total connection with the river and its life.

12:00 pm – Lunch and Rest

3:00 pm – Water Giants and Piranha Fishing

We explore the impressive Victoria Regia, the largest aquatic plant in the world, while watching iguanas soaking up the sun. Then, we try piranha fishing, learning about their habits and the skill it takes to catch them.

5:30 pm – Sunset at Sapote Lagoon

We enjoy sunset at one of the ten-plus lagoons in Yanayacu, where the water reflects the colors of the sky and the sounds of the jungle create a mystical atmosphere.

7:45 pm – Night Walk in the Jungle

With flashlights in hand, we venture out in search of tarantulas, giant frogs, and other creatures that only reveal themselves at night.

Day 3: Life Along the River (B/L)

6:30 am – Breakfast and Water Expedition

We head out on a boat excursion to explore lagoons or creeks upriver, searching for different species of birds and monkeys.

9:00 am – Encounter with the community

We visit the village of San Juan de Yanayacu, where many of our guides and staff are from. You'll meet local families, see everyday life in the jungle, and find handmade crafts created with natural fibers and traditional techniques.

10:30 am – Departure PRE TOUR

We start our journey back to the city, taking with us the memories of the Amazon.

1:30 pm – Arrival at Iquitos airport.

Recommended flight Iquitos – Lima at 04:00 pm

1:00 pm – Departure POST TOUR

4:00 pm – Arrival to Iquitos airport.

Recommended flight Iquitos – Lima after 5.30 pm
