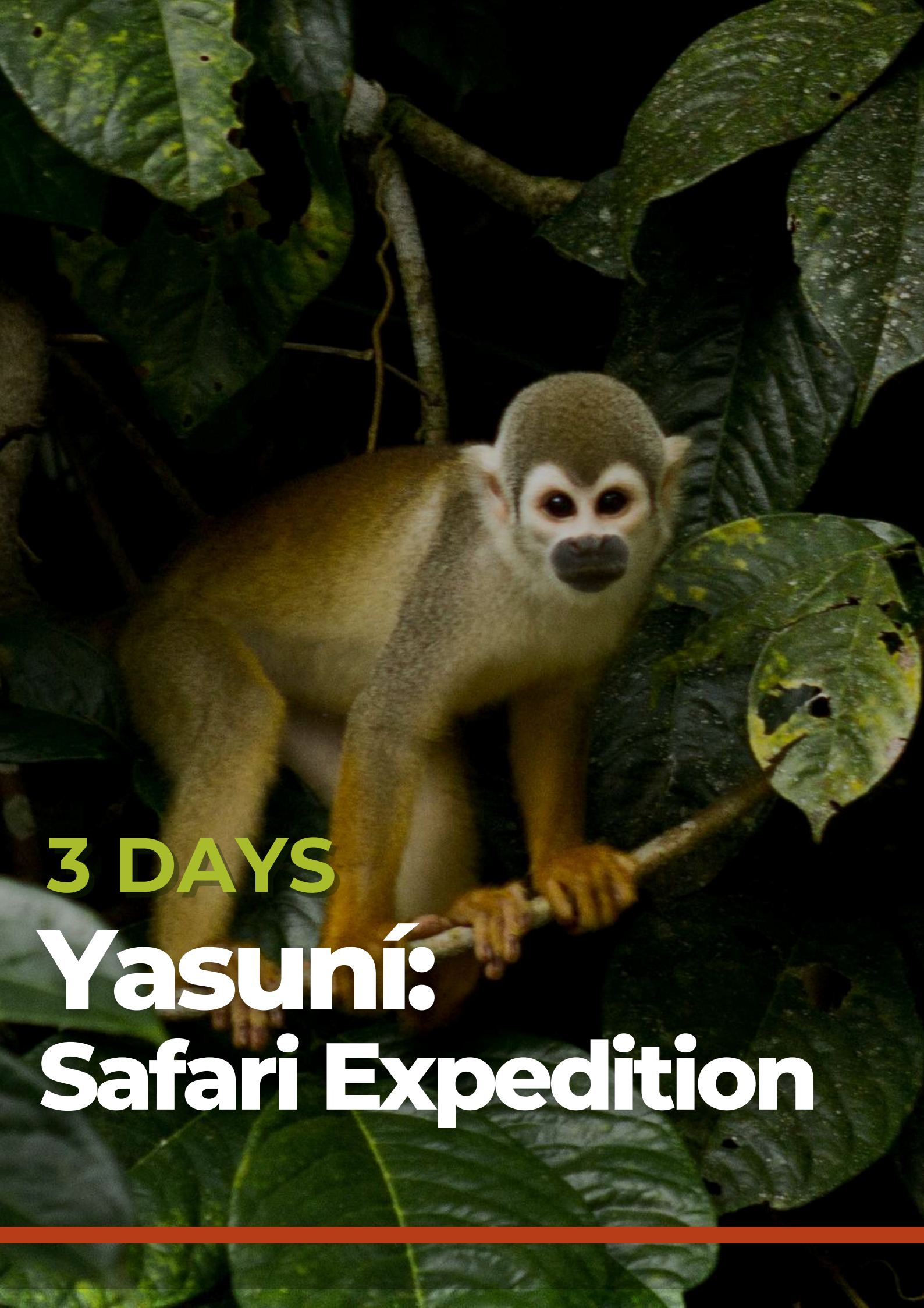

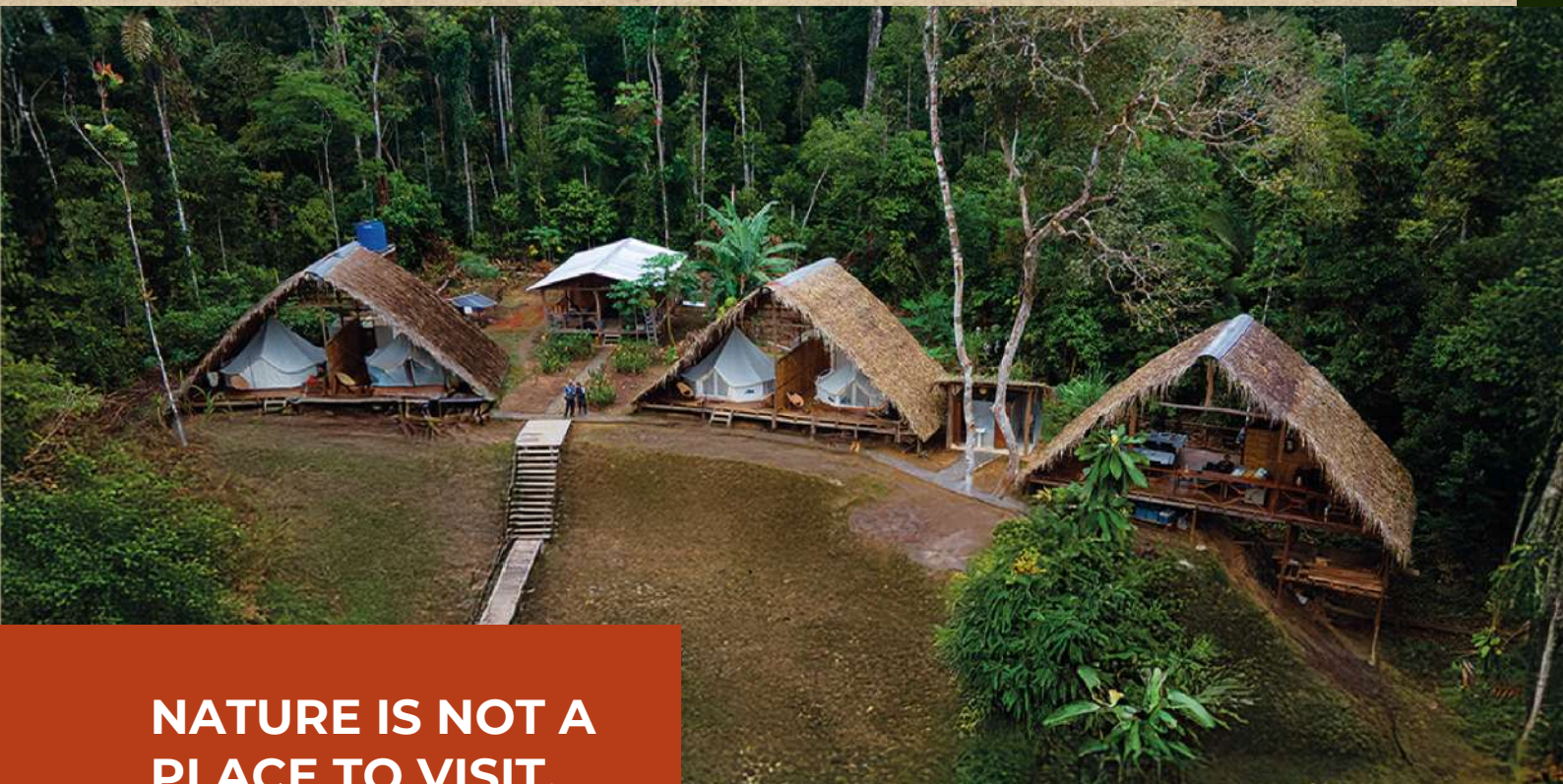

The Yasuní Intangible Reserve is one of the most biodiverse places on the planet, with over 2,000 plant species and over 1,000 animal species. Wildlife has found a home deep within the Amazon rainforest.

In addition to its incredible natural wealth, Yasuní is home to the Waorani (or Wao) people, including communities living in voluntary isolation such as the Tagaeri and Taromenani. The Waorani have a deep connection to the land and live in harmony with the biodiversity that surrounds them. Their knowledge and traditions are key to the preservation of this unique ecosystem.

Due to its immense value and importance, this area is heavily protected, and all activities are strictly regulated to ensure its conservation. By supporting projects that work with local communities and protect the area's natural and cultural heritage, you help prevent the loss of this natural wonder and the vibrant culture of the Waorani people.

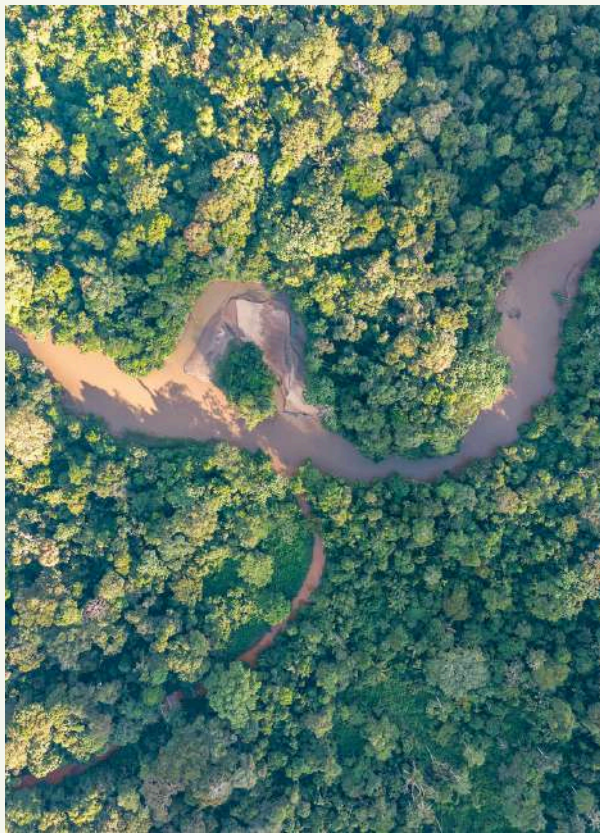

Day 1. From El Coca to Yasuni



The gateway to adventure

Our journey begins in Coca. From there, we'll head to the Shiripuno River. Once there, we'll take a motorized canoe for approximately two hours to reach the entrance to Waorani territory.

Then we will have lunch at 2:00 PM. After lunch, we will go for a walk and then visit the Waorani at Gaba's house to learn about traditional hunting and the use of their handcrafted weapons, such as the blowgun and spear, as well as observe their jewelry and art.

Back at the camp, you will have dinner at 7:00 p.m. and after dinner, we will take a short night walk to look for tree frogs, spiders, snakes, or insects.

Day 2. Kayaking and a viewpoint at the summit



Start your day with breakfast at 6:30 a.m. We'll begin a 5-hour kayak tour down the Shiripuno River. Afterward, we'll relax for a while before enjoying a packed lunch at 1:00 p.m.

Afterward, explore the forest on a 4- to 5-hour hike to reach a breathtaking summit with a 180-degree view of the pristine rainforest. We'll return by motorized canoe at 6:00 p.m.—be sure to keep an eye out for caimans and other nocturnal wildlife.

The day ends with dinner at 8:00 p.m.

HIGH OCCUPANCY DATES

For Christmas and New Year's Eve departures, a 10% surcharge applies. Special conditions apply.

CHILDREN POLICY

SINGLE ACCOMMODATION

Single supplement is 80%.

PAYMENT AND CANCELLATION POLICIES
